On behalf of the Haverford Civic Association, we welcome you to this wonderful area and want to let you know what your civic is doing and encourage you to join us as members or renew your membership.

The Board of Directors of the civic meets each month and reviews developments in Lower Merion Township that impact residents in Haverford. All meetings are open to the public. These meetings include reports from members of the Lower Merion Township's Board of Commissioners that touch on a range of concerns, including development plans requiring zoning or planning board approvals, the township and school district budgets, and property taxes. Additional concerns included local crime and crime prevention efforts, issues involving utilities, such as improvements to lines and bridges in the area, and the list goes on. We stay on top of these developments for the benefit of our neighbors and our community.

What else does the Haverford Civic do? With the help of our members and local businesses, Haverford Civic arranges for and pays the cost of placement and maintenance of the snowflake shaped lights that are installed each winter holiday season along Lancaster Avenue. The Haverford Civic also assists with the maintenance and plantings necessary to maintain Sharpe Parke and Bird Sanctuary and the railroad station. We bring in outside speakers and presenters on topics of interest or concern.
