- ❖ Owner 130 Avon Rd. tabled request for garage because would need storm water management
- ❖ HARB denied Ardmore theater 7 story project
- ❖ Feb 26 final vote zoning
- ❖ LMSD request relief for new middle school fields- Commissioners denied for now as wants preservation of historic gardens. There is time to discuss again as fields will be built after school constructed. Mansion will be occupied until 2023.
